

The Breast Cancer Project is an established comprehensive effort in our service area which encourages and educates women about breast health and the importance of early detection. This effort provides screening mammograms and diagnostic mammography services to uninsured and underinsured women who meet ACS High Risk criteria or are forty years of age and older. This program is made possible through grant funding from IBCAT, the Michigan City Women’s Bowling Association, the La Porte City Fire Department Local 360 and other community partners.

Do I meet the Criteria?

- Age 40 and older *OR* meet High Risk Status as defined by American Cancer Society (physician must determine ACS High Risk Status)
- Uninsured, underinsured, or participating in a High Deductible Health Care (HDHC) plan
- Income Guidelines (*last updated 1.15.19*):

How do I get a voucher?

If you meet all three criteria above, please schedule an appointment with your physician. Bring this paper with you to the appointment or reference the Healthcare Foundation of La Porte’s mammogram voucher program.
